


The installation of bMCA device (drivers) and software might fail under Windows 8 due to the new restricted policy for installing third party drivers (\*.INF) that does not contain digital signature.

To proceed with this driver installation you must disable the Windows 8 driver enforcement option.


The following steps show you how to do this:

Using the PC Settings, press SHIFT key while clicking at the Restart menu option from POWER





The following screen should appear




Chose the option "Troubleshoot"


From the Troubleshoot menu chose "Advanced options", as shown below:



And from Advanced options select "Startup settings"



From "Startup Settings" screen chose Restart



On next booting screen chose option 7 "Disable driver signature enforcement" by pressing "F7" key from the keyboard

## Startup Settings

Press a number to choose from the options below:

Use number keys or functions keys F1-F9.

- 1) Enable debugging
- 2) Enable boot logging
- 3) Enable low-resolution video
- 4) Enable Safe Mode
- 5) Enable Safe Mode with Networking
- 6) Enable Safe Mode with Command Prompt
- 7) Disable driver signature enforcement
- 8) Disable early launch anti-malware protection
- 9) Disable automatic restart after failure

Press Enter to return to your operating system
